The purpose of this series is to provide guidance on implementing the recently updated <u>VA/DOD Clinical</u> <u>Practice Guidelines for the Assessment and Management of Patients at Risk for Suicide</u> (CPG). She serves as the Associate Director of VA's Behavioral Health Quality Enhancement Research Initiative (QUERI) and as a core investigator with the South Central Mental Illness Research, Education, and Clinical Center (MIRECC). Dr. Landes is also an Associate Professor at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences and core faculty of the UAMS Center for Implementation Research. Dr. Landes' clinical expertise is in suicide prevention interventions, including Dialectical Behavior Therapy. Dr. Landes' research interests are in the implementation of evidence-based mental health interventions, with a focus on suicide prevention and larger health care systems such as the VA. She has received research funding from VA Health Services Research & Development (HSR&D), QUERI, the National Institute of Mental Health, and the Department of Defense.
