Congress established multiple Mental Illness Research, Education & Clinical Centers (MIRECC) for the purpose of “researching the causes and treatments of mental disorders and using education to put new knowledge into practice in the VA.”

Each of the 13 nationwide MIRECCs is charged with a unique, dynamic mission. The Veterans Integrated Service Network (VISN) 19 Rocky Mountain MIRECC fulfills a critical mission studying suicide, with the goal of reducing suicidal ideation and behaviors in the Veteran population.

Specifically, the VISN 19 MIRECC focuses on promising clinical interventions, as well as the cognitive and neurobiological underpinnings of suicidal thoughts and behaviors that may lead to promising prevention strategies.

- 2) Current curriculum vitae
- 3) Three letters of recommendation
- 4) Sample de-identified neuro/psychological evaluation report; and, summary of number and types of neuro/psychological tests administered.



Application Requirements

- U.S. Citizenship
- Completion of graduate training in APA-accredited doctoral program in Clinical or Counseling Psychology
- Completion of APA-accredited internship
- Males must register for draft by age 26

Our program aims to train psychologists to become outstanding clinicians/clinical researchers in the high priority area of Veteran mental health care. Fellows benefit from mentorship with top psychologist/researchers in the fields of suicidality, traumatic brain injury, and co-occurring psychiatric conditions.

Fellows train in a large hospital located in Denver, CO. Through supervised clinical training and a focus on evidence-based assessment, intervention and consultation, Fellows gain the skills necessary to be successful, independent practitioners.

As part of a network of participating MIRECCs, (administered through the Office of Academic Affiliations), VISN 19 also links to shared resources including didactics, academic and clinical research efforts. VISN 19 Fellows thus become part of a national cohort of Postdocs working towards a shared mission of serving today's Veterans.
