

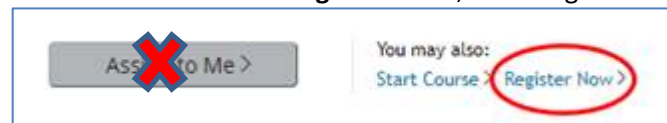

The presenters will review the evidence base for crisis response planning and the Safety Planning Intervention (SPI). They will review each type of plan, highlighting similarities and differences. Additionally, there will be a review of Advanced Training in the SPI (ASPI) in the VA. Attendees will be able to discuss how crisis response plans and safety plans positively impact Veteran outcomes by reducing suicidal behaviors. This virtual knowledge-based webinar training will discuss how advanced training improves provider competency and the quality of safety plans, which impacts Veteran outcomes by reducing suicide behaviors.
