



Therapeutic risk management (TRM) is a process based upon clinical risk management, one that is patient-centered, supportive of the treatment process, and maintains the therapeutic alliance. A crucial element of TRM is risk stratification and documentation. This virtual knowledge-based webinar will address risk stratification for healthcare teams that will attend to risk in terms of both severity and temporality and will offer related documentation strategies.
