Program Description: Risk management is a necessity of mental health practice and this requires a thoughtful approach to suicide risk assessment and management. Even prior to COVID-19, VHA committed significant resources towards web-based versions of evidence-based psychotherapies as a means of increasing access to care. These include interventions aimed at insomnia (Path to Better Sleep, CBT-I); and, managing stress (Moving Forward, Problem Solving Therapy). Both are also useful upstream suicide prevention interventions. Efforts are underway to develop a new web-based program to serve as a downstream suicide prevention intervention based on VA/DOD Clinical Practice Guidelines. This virtual knowledge-based webinar training will inform attendees and healthcare teams through discussion on the current state of the science, and present VHA digital resources, with the goal of increasing their use.
