

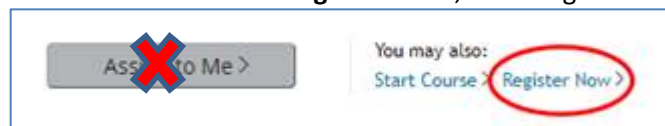

Program Description: Risk management is a necessity of mental health practice and requires a thoughtful approach to suicide risk assessment and management. Routine screening for suicide risk by providers and healthcare teams in the healthcare setting has been an area of considerable debate. However, an accumulating body of evidence indicates that suicide risk screening and follow up evaluation are critical components of effective, patient-centered suicide risk management.

In 2019, the VA/DoD Clinical Practice Guideline for the Assessment and Management of Patients at Risk for Suicide strongly recommended “using cognitive behavioral therapy-based interventions focused on suicide prevention for patients with a recent history of self-directed violence to reduce incidents of self-directed violence”. This virtual knowledge-based webinar training will provide an overview of Cognitive Behavioral Therapy for Suicide Prevention (CBT-SP) including the key cognitive and behavioral strategies that are used to target suicidal behavior and the evidence supporting its use.
