

Everyone's story is different. Sometimes, the treatment you need is different, too. VA researchers are testing a new way to tell which PTSD treatment will work best for each Veteran, right from the beginning.

We are looking for <u>Veterans</u> with <u>PTSD</u> (age 21 to 75) who are willing to participate in a research study. Volunteers will receive up to \$700 for completing the study.

The medication prazosin may work better for some people than for others. In this study, we will measure your personal response to prazosin. This may help us learn how other Veterans may respond to this medication.

This will require:

- Up to 20 visits to the Seattle or American Lake VA
- Receiving the medication prazosin (phase 1)
- Receiving a pill that will contain either prazosin or an inactive placebo (phase 2)
- Taking part in a 1–2 day medical and mental health assessment
